**Visit to Shaftesbury  
on Tuesday 5th July**

Lots to see in this historic Dorset market town - including the remains of the Saxon nunnery set in a beautiful garden; the excellent visitor centre attached to the Abbey ruins, displaying what is believed to be the burial casket of the murdered young King Edward II, views over Blackmore Vale from the Park Walk, the town's Gold Hill Museum and Garden, Gold Hill itself, (scene of the famous Hovis advertisement), the C15th church of St Peter and the Shaftesbury Arts Centre. We will be visiting on market day. Lots of places to buy lunch.

This trip will be opened to the whole parish but members of the Friends have the chance to book first.

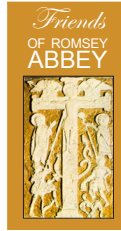

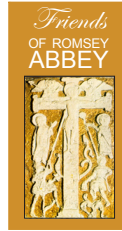

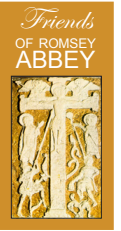
